Advance Notice of Roadworks: Burtons Way – Carriageway Works

We will be carrying out carriageway works on Burtons Way from the junction with Kingfisher Drive to the junction of Burtons Park Road on Thursday 01 September 2016. The duration of the Works is expected to be for one day.

In order to carry out the works safely it will be necessary to restrict vehicle access and temporarily close Burtons Way for the duration of the Works. The road closure will be an all day (24hr closure) and has been arranged to coincide with the school summer holidays to minimise disruption.

The Works will be carried out from 8.00am on Thursday 01 September 2016.

Diversion routes for traffic will be clearly signed and access to shops/ businesses, parking areas and to all fronting properties will be maintained during the works.

It will also be necessary to temporarily close existing bus stops whilst carrying out the works. Alternative temporary stops will be provided for the No. 966 bus which will be clearly marked on the affected bus stops.

When will Works happen?

Details of when the works are to be carried out and dates of planned road closures will be clearly signed on the street and are given below:
