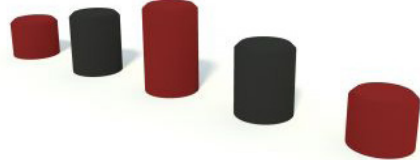
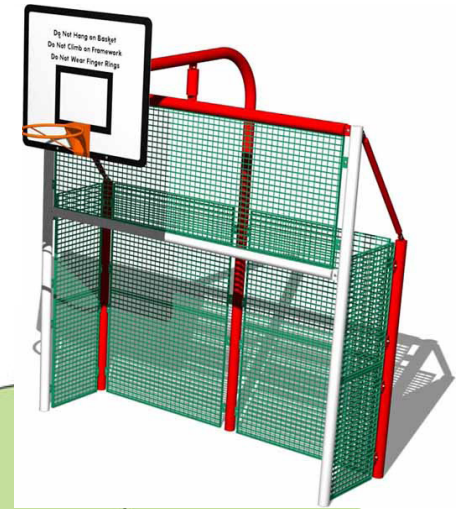




Trailplay items will be installed in the centre of the park, enclosed by trees. The play will have a spinning disc that can be used by children of all abilities.



A goal end with basketball hoop will be installed within a hard standing area for ball games. A low mound will be formed around the ball area utilising the spoil from onsite excavations

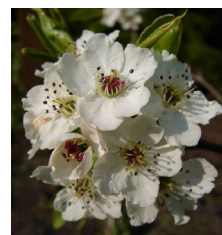
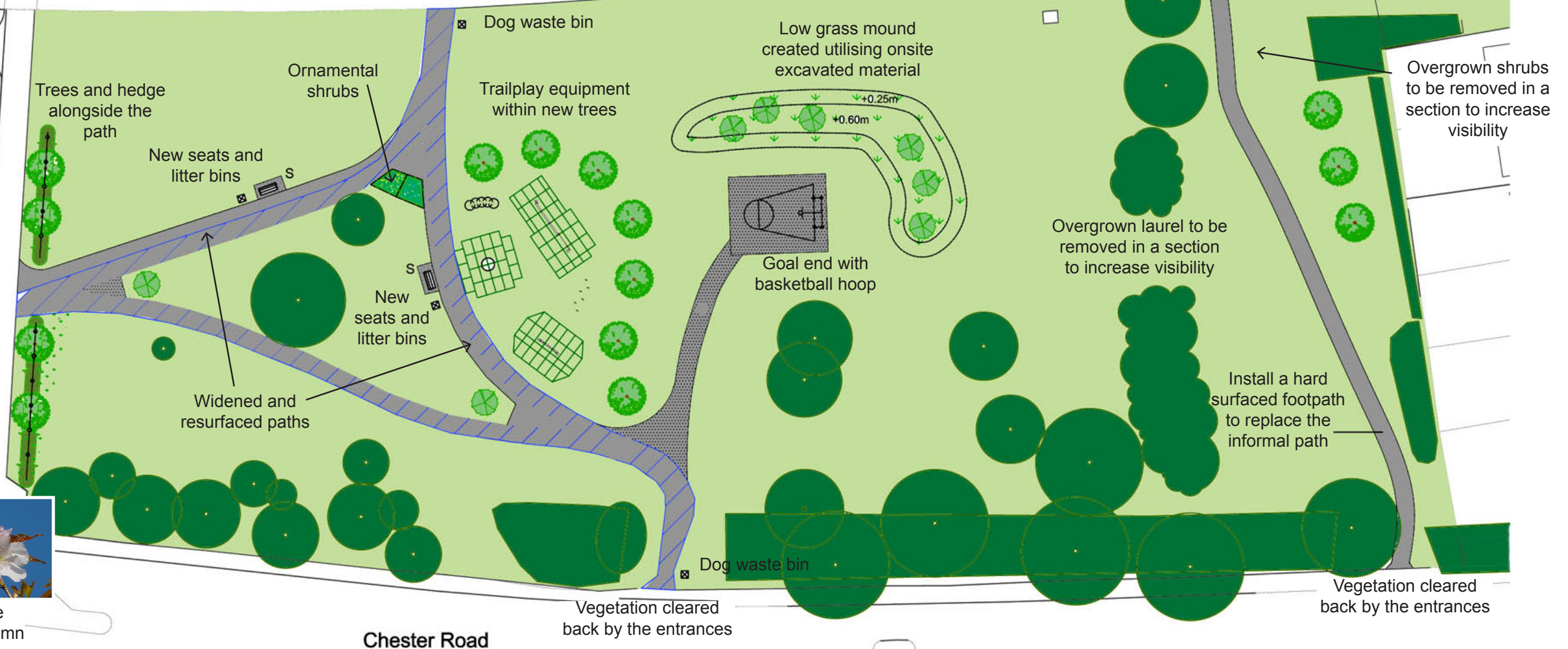


Windward Way

Adjacent housing site currently under construction



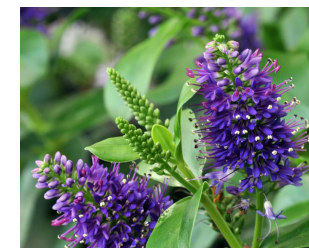
Cherry trees which have summer blossom and autumn colour in their leaves. These will frame the footpath.
